

Request an absentee ballot with a smartphone or computer



Step 1

Go to: mvp.sos.ga.gov

Double check that you're registered and all of your personal details are up to date, including your mailing address so that you can receive your absentee ballot in the mail.

**What if I'm not registered or I need to update my voter information?*

Head to registertovote.sos.ga.gov to start the registration process online. You can change your voter info on this site too.

Step 2

Go to: ballotrequest.sos.ga.gov

Click "Request" and fill out the required fields (first/last name, DOB, state ID or drivers license number, and county).

**Once you submit your request, download the PDF copy to save for your records.*

You completed the first step!

Now wait to receive your ballot in the mail.



Fulton County will begin mailing ballots on September 15th so you should receive it by the first week of October. If by October 1st you still have not received it, call the Fulton County Elections Office at (404) 612-7060. The DeKalb County Elections Office can be reached at (404) 298-4020.

**If they can't help you, call the Voter Protection Hotline at 866-687-8683.*

Now that you have your ballot, do you have access to transportation?

Yes.

Find the nearest ballot drop box

Locate the nearest or most accessible absentee ballot drop box. As long as you use a drop box within your county, it doesn't matter which one you choose.

Mail it in before October 15th

The ballot comes with an envelope with your county's election office address so all you need is a .55 cent forever stamp.

**Make sure that you seal the envelope and sign the outside.*

|
Drive, ride, scoot or walk there

Whatever you do, make sure to drop off your ballot before 7pm on November 3rd. The sooner, the better!

**Make sure that you seal the envelope and sign the outside.*

Track your ballot at mvp.sos.ga.gov! Simply type in your info (first initial, last name, county, and DOB), then click on "Click here for absentee ballot status".

You voted!

Now sit back and relax.

If you have not received a ballot by October 15th, make a plan to vote early. When you go to vote in-person, you will be required to sign an affidavit since you officially requested an absentee ballot. But don't worry - you are perfectly in your right to vote in-person!

**You can vote at any early voting precinct in your county. Head to mvp.sos.ga.gov to find the times & locations.*
